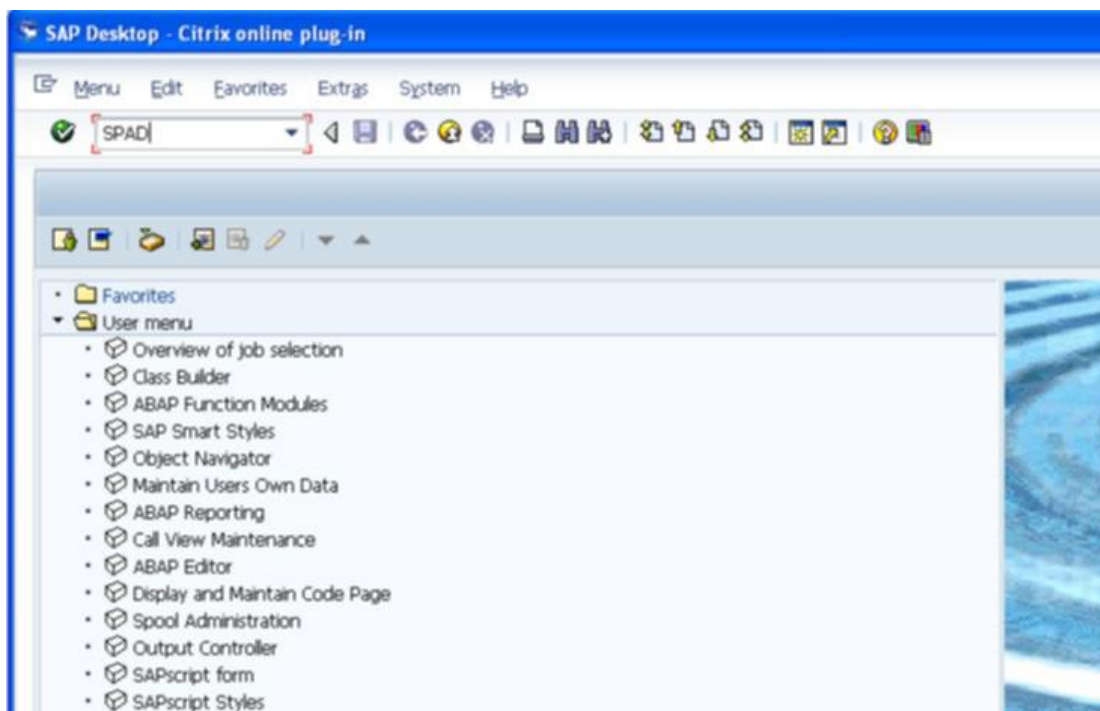

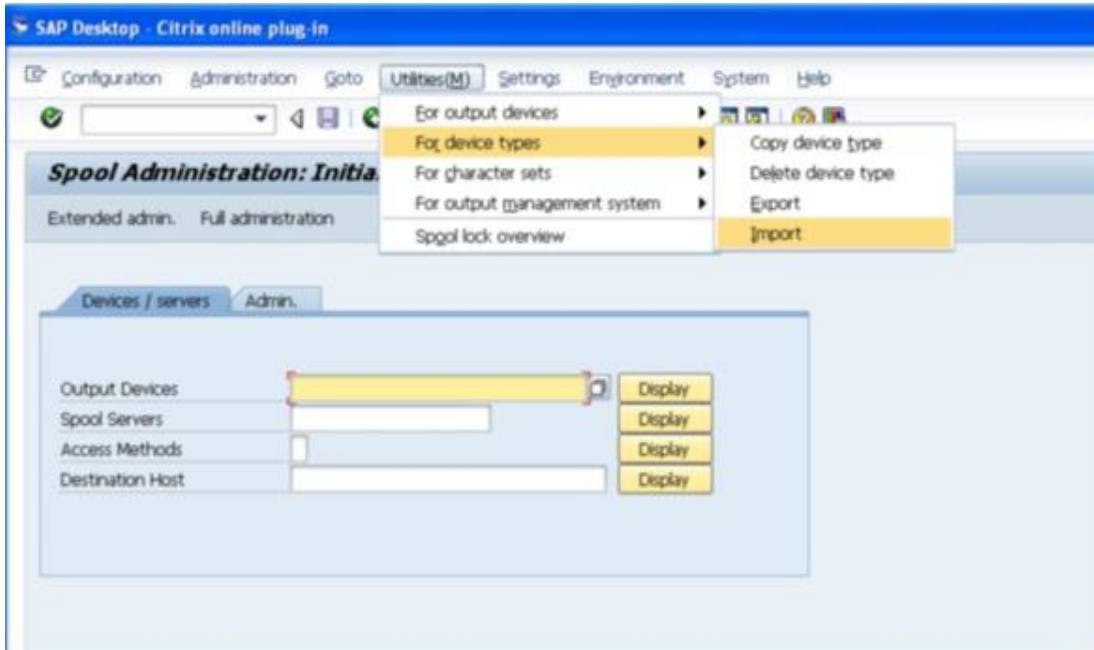
### Installation Procedure

1. Download the Mi Series SAP Device Type from the IntelliTech International, Inc. web site: <http://info.intellitech-intl.com/download-intellibar-drivers--software-utilities>
2. Extract the Mi Series SAP Device Type files and note the location on your computer.
3. In SAP select the SPAD transaction.

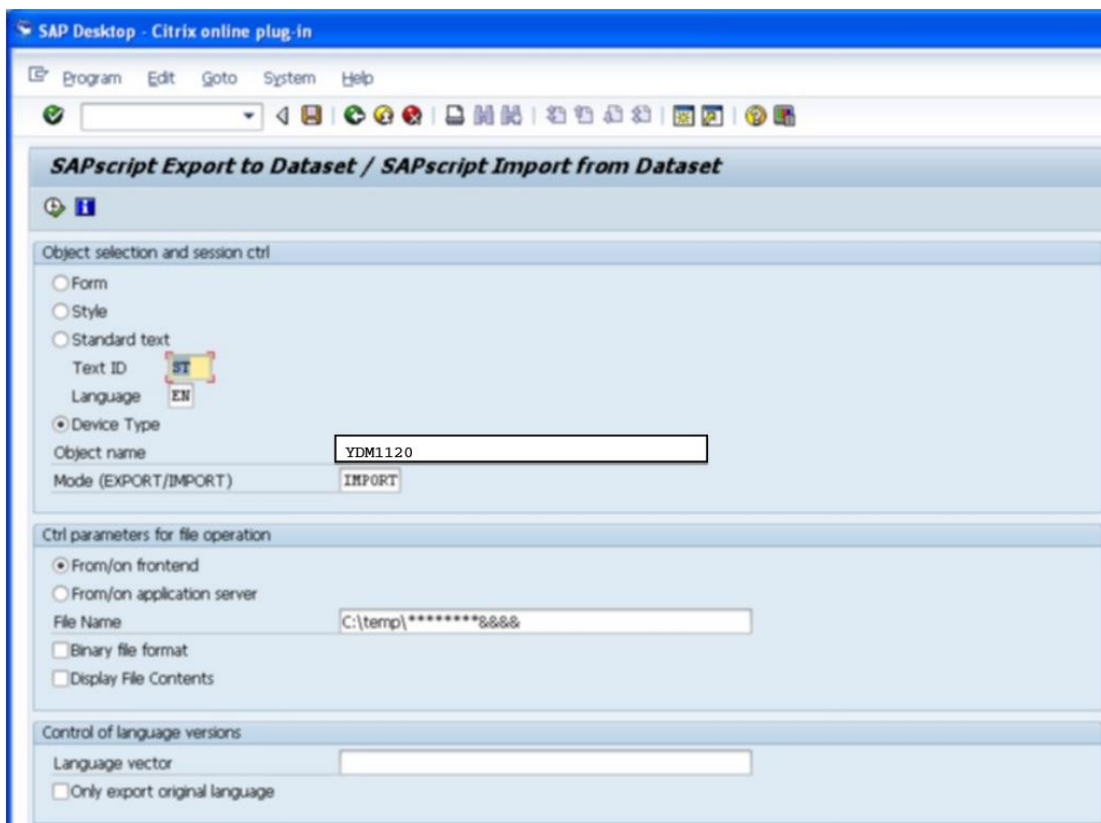
**NOTE:** Depending on the version of SAP being used, the following screenshots may differ.



4. Select **Utilities** > **For device types** > **Import**.



5. Select the **Device Type** radio button and then enter the Object name of the device: YDM1120.



6. Select the **Execute** button.
7. Select the **Local Object** button.
8. Route to the location where the device type (step 2) and select **Open**.

**NOTE:** The message “**Object successfully Imported**” will display when the installation has been completed.
